TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1) A participant in this tournament must be a member of GBUSBC for the 2016-17 season.
- 2) A valid couples team shall consist of one male and one female bowler. The same 2 bowlers may bowl together more than once, but only their highest score will be allowed to cash.
- 3) Handicap will be based on 90% of 230.
- 4) Participants will use their composite GBUSBC average from the summer and winter 2016-2017 season. Those without a 2016-2017 GBUSBC composite average, will use their current GBUSBC average of at least 21 games as of the first day of the tournament. All others will bowl scratch. Any entry failing to comply with the above rules, shall forfeit all claims to any prize money and/or return of their entry fee. **THE TOURNAMENT MANAGER HAS THE RIGHT TO RE-RATE ANY BOWLER AT ANY TIME.**
- 5) Rules 319a/3 (average verification), 319e (15 pin tournament averages), and Rule 319d (reporting of winnings of \$300.00 or more per event or \$1,000 annual in any previous tournament(s) prior to bowling) will be enforced. Failure to comply with any of these rules shall be cause to forfeit entry fee and prize winnings.
- 6) The total fee will be \$26.00 per bowler. The optional scratch fee will be \$5.00 per bowler. The prize fund will be dispersed 100%. Prizes will be awarded on a ratio of at least one (1) out of six (6) entries.
- 7) Proper fees must accompany entry or it will not be accepted. Checks covering entry fees shall be made payable to GBUSBC. A \$35.00 Fee will be charged for any NSF check and must be paid in cash prior to bowling your first event.
- 8) All entries must be submitted to the association manager in person or via the address on front, postmarked on or before November 17, 2017, and received by November 19, 2017.
- 9) Official scores will be taken from computer printout per USBC Rule 327a. Unofficial standings will be posted at the end of each day.
- 10) Premature termination of the tournament brought about by war, national emergency or emergency causes relating thereto or therefrom, fire, natural disaster and any other reason beyond the control of the GBUSBC shall cause, to the extent required thereby, any advertised prizes, guaranteed or otherwise, to be prorated in accordance with the number of entrants who have bowled in each of the respective events up to the time of such termination.
- 11) In accordance with USBC rule 18 the use of abrasives on the surface of bowling ball during tournament play will result in disqualification and may also result in suspension of membership.
- 12) In accordance with USBC Rule 12, the application of any foreign substances on any part of the approach that detracts from the possibility of other players having normal conditions is prohibited. This includes, but is not limited to such substances as talcum powder, pumice and resin on shoes, and soft rubber soles and/or heels that rub off on the approach.
- 13) No non-participants, including children, will be allowed in the bowlers' area.
- 14) All USBC rules regarding tournament play shall govern this tournament.
