

Senior Ladies All City Point System and Qualifications Effective August 1, 2013

- Any dues paying USBC/GBUSBC lady bowler, 50 years or older as of August 1st, in good standing with USBC and GBUSBC.
- Minimum of 54 Games or more in a GBUSBC (USBC certified) League during the current winter season. Season starts August 1 and ends July 31 of the next year. Bowler must be age qualified at the start of the season.
- Should a tie exist, tie breakers will be used in the following order:
1st-Highest average—2nd-No. of houses with 165+ average—3rd-No. of leagues with a 165+ average
- Only honor scores and averages bowled in Greater Birmingham USBC (USBC Certified) events qualify for points for the Senior Ladies All City Teams.
- If a Lady Senior makes the Open, Ladies and Senior Ladies Teams, it is HER choice on which division to compete under. She can choose only one.
